BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT BULGARIA

Location

The Republic of Bulgaria lies in Southeastern Europe. It is situated in the eastern half of the Balkan Peninsula. It borders the Black Sea to the east, Greece and Turkey to the south, Serbia and the Republic of Macedonia to the west and Romania to the North, mostly along the Danube.



Brief history of Bulgaria

Bulgaria has a history of 1300 years. **Old Great Bulgaria** was founded by Khan Kubrat in 632 on a territory spread between the Caucasus, the Volga river and the Carpathian mountains. Around 654 Great Bulgaria was divided into three parts. One of Kubrat's sons, Asparukh, migrated towards the Danube delta to the west, where he formed the Danube Bulgaria. The year 681 is considered the beginning of the **First Bulgarian Empire**, when Khan Asparukh signed a peace treaty with Thrace. Bulgaria showed cultural heyday until 1018. The Cyrillic alphabet was created, updated versions of which are used in the Bulgarian, Russian, Macedonian, Serbian, Ukrainian, Mongolian and Belarusian languages. During the reign of Tsar Simeon I the Great Bulgaria was in a period, later called the Golden Age of Bulgarian literature. Bulgaria was under the **Byzantine rule** during the period 1018-1186. In 1186 the brothers Asen and Peter established the **Second Bulgarian Empire** with its capital based in Turnovo. In 1396 the country came under the **Ottoman rule**, that lasted five centuries – until March 3, 1878 when the Treaty of San Stefano was signed and the Bulgarian state restored. The Union of Eastern Rumelia with the Bulgarian Principality was proclaimed on September 6, 1885. The independence of Bulgaria was officially declared on September 22, 1908. The form of government was a monarchy lead by Tsar Boris III. After World War II, Bulgaria fell within the Soviet sphere of influence and in 1946 became a People's Republic. The beginning of Bulgaria's transition from communism to market economy was made at the end of 1989. In 2004, Bulgaria successfully completed the negotiations with the European Union and since January 1, 2007 Bulgaria is a full member of EU.

Climate

Bulgaria has a temperate continental climate (2000 to 2400 sunny hours annually), with four seasons: cold and sometimes damp winter with snowfalls and average temperature of 0° C; warm and very often damp spring; hot and dry summer with average temperatures of 26° C and warm and sunny autumn. The average annual temperature is 10.5° C

Tourism

Tourism is one of the major branches of the economy in Bulgaria. The country is rich with its cultural and historical sights. Tourism is developed mostly along the Black sea coast and in the mountains. The most popular sea resorts are Golden sands, Sunny Beach, Albena, Nessebur and Sozopol, and the most popular mountain resorts are Borovets, Pamporovo and Bansko.

BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT SVISHTOV

Location

Svishtov is situated in Central Northern Bulgaria, on the right bank of the Danube river. The town lies 2 295 km from the springs and 555 km from the river's estuary. This is where the most southern point of the Danube river ($43^{\circ} 37'$ north) is located. The port of Svishtov is the only Danube port that is so far inside the territory of the country and is the shortest way from the Danube through Stara Planina passes and the valley of Maritsa river to the Aegean Sea.

The location, the rich fertile land, the big river – all these have created conditions for settlement and building of many and various villages on the territory of the present city of Svishtov. The archaeological excavations and the funeral mounds found, prove the existence of a number of prehistoric villages – during the Neolithic, Eneolithic and Bronze Ages. Many finds are also discovered from the early Iron age, when the Thracian tribes settled here.

The Roman town of Nove (Novgrad, Novo selishte) was built on the foundations of an early Thracian village and existed almost 6 centuries (first to seventh century A.D). During the whole time of its existence, Nove has been a border point. When Claudius was an emperor, the VIII Augustus Legion resided in Nove, while the First Italic Legion was there from 69 A.D. until the end of antiquity. The Roman and late Graeco-Roman town of Novae (Nove) is included in the list of the 100 most endangered cultural sites (<http://wmf.org>). The excavations of the Roman town of Novae are 3,5 km to the east of Svishtov.

There has been another, separate roman village on the territory of the present-day Svishtov (in the Kaleto place), that has had subsidiary functions regarding the I Italic legion in Nove. This village in Kaleto existed during the First Bulgarian Empire, during the Byzantine rule, the Second Bulgarian Empire and the ottoman rule.

The mediaeval Fortress of Svishtov – the Fortress of Rocky peak (Kaleto) was built on the ruins of an ancient roman tower. So far, some half-destroyed walls, reaching 7 m in height, are preserved. An amphitheatre and a sun dial were built at the “Kaleto” park in Svishtov in 2005. This is one of the many parks in town, which is a preferred place not only for rest, but also for organizing various cultural events. At the beginning of XIX century, the town had a reputation of an important trade and educational centre. It is one of the most busy ports on the Danube and serves as connection between Bulgaria and the West for import and export of goods.

Svishtov is the town of the 100 first things. Here are some of the most important ones:

- ✓ The first donation to school purposes was made in 1812 by Phillip Sakelarievich, who was born in Svishtov, but was trading in Vienna;
- ✓ Svishtov is the first town liberated from the Turkish yoke and the first civil administration is established here as well;

- ✓ The first in Bulgaria high-school of trade was found in Svishtov thanks to the donation of Dimitar Hadzhivasilev from Svishtov and built by the Austrian architect Paul Brant, like the high school in Vienna;
- ✓ The history of the choral singing starts from Svishtov. The first Bulgarian choir was set up in Svishtov in 1868;
- ✓ The first Bulgarian cultural house was found in Svishtov with the act of donation of Kiril D. Avramov;
- ✓ Svishtov is the native town of the author of the first printed book in modern Bulgarian language- Philip Stanislavov; the author of the Bulgarian anthem – Tsvetan Radoslavov; the great writer Aleko Konstantinov.

Svishtov is well-known not only as the town of the 100 first things, but as well as the town of the benefactors. There is no significant initiative – building, school, church or institution, that have not had benefactors behind (Dimitar A. Tsenov - Academy of Economics; Dimitar Hadzhivasilev – High school of trade; Kiril D. Avramov – First Bulgarian cultural house, which is a theatre and museum today, and about 600 more names of benefactors from Svishtov only during the Bulgarian national revival.

Climate

The terrain of the area is slightly hilly and level above all. The level terrain and the fact that the town is open to the north facilitate the access of air masses with continental origin. The continental character of the climate is expressed in high

annual amplitude and insufficient quantity of rainfall. Summer is hot and dry and the winter is cold and with snowfalls.

SECTION II. TRANSPORT AND ACCOMMODATION

Transport

Svishtov lies 260 km from Sofia, 260 km from Varna, 90 km from Gorna Oryahovitsa and 90 km from V. Turnovo. Traveling to the mentioned cities can be done by train or bus. Duration and price of traveling by bus one-way to Sofia is 4 hrs – 14 lv (EURO 7); to Varna – 4 hrs 15 min – 16 lv (8 EURO); to Gorna Oryahovitsa – 1 hr 50 min – 6 lv (EURO 3); to Pleven – 1 hr 10 min – 5 lv (EURO 2.5); to Russe – 1 hr 30 min – 6 lv (EURO 3); to Veliko Turnovo – 2 hrs – 6 lv (EURO 3). Traveling by train is longer and there is a difference in the price of tickets compared to bus tickets ranging from 2 to 4 lv. (EURO 1-2) You can drive to Svishtov by taxi as well. The price you will pay depends on the taxi carrier's tariff – minimum is 0,45 lv (EURO 0.25) per 1 km. traveled. There are airports in the cities of Sofia, Varna and Gorna Oryahovitsa.

You can sail with the regular passenger line from Zimnich (Romania) to Svishtov and back every Friday, Saturday and Sunday – one-way ticket price – EUR 2.50.

Average price of accommodation in a single room is about 40 lv. (EURO 20).
Average price of sample lunch including 3 meals is about 12 lv. (EURO 6).

Banks

Banks will exchange foreign currency and traveler's cheques for levs and vice versa. Foreign residents may open leva (levs) and foreign currency accounts, and it is possible to send money orders and transfer payments. Changing money is also possible at exchange offices in hotels and numerous small exchange offices. Their working hours are 10.00 to 20.00 hrs.

In the town of Svishtov there can be found branches of many Bulgarian and a number of foreign banks.

The customer service working hours are 8.30 to 16.30 hrs. The minimum deposit to open an account is 100 Euro and withdrawals can be made at any branch of the respective bank in Bulgaria. Before leaving the country, however, students should be aware that an account can only be closed with the branch it was opened.

Visa regulations for tourists are liberal: Bulgaria has agreements with numerous countries for allowing visitors to stay in the country without a visa for up to 90 days. Health Insurance

All Erasmus students coming to Bulgaria should have a prepaid health insurance for the period they are going to spend in the country. They are advised to visit polyclinics if they need medical treatment in Bulgaria. A medical examination at the clinic will cost about 50 leva (25 Euro). A home visit by a physician during the day is 60 leva (30 Euro) and during the night – 70 leva (35 Euro).

ISIC card and Driving licence

You are advised to bring your ISIC card. The card is recognized in Bulgaria, and can be helpful when purchasing international train tickets, plane tickets or going

to museums. With your ISIC card you can sometimes get special discounts at students' disco clubs.

Motor vehicle drivers should possess a valid local or international driver's licence. You need a "green card" insurance for your vehicle.

Profile

merchants and intellectuals cherished in their hearts a dearest wish to measure the economic, cultural and intellectual growth of the town with European standards and development. This roused greatly the zeal for renewal. "The great flames" of patriotism and Renaissance enthusiasm gave rise to noble beneficiary traditions to serve the needs of education. In an article in "Tsarigradski newspaper", from July, 1858, the town of Svishtov was mentioned as "the Bulgarian capital of teaching"

The name of Dimitar Apostolov Tsenov, with his invaluable contribution to the community and the country, stands out among the noble figures of the benefactors from Svishtov.

"Dimitar Tsenov is a great Bulgarian, a continuator of the glorious deeds of his predecessors", says the Bulgarian Academician Georgi Danailov. The Academy of Economics vindicates the fame of the Benefactor and the pride of Svishtov as an academic centre.

The Decree of November 8th, 1936 , signed by Tsar Boris III, reads: "A High School of Economics, bearing the name of Dimitar ApostolovTsenov, is found in Svishtov with the aim of teaching the theory of economics and applying the knowledge obtained in the separate branches of the economic studies. (The State Gazette, Sept 5th ,1936).

EUROPEAN CREDIT TRANSFER SYSTEM (ECTS)

The European credit transfer system (**ECTS**) has been worked out within the framework of Erasmus program. ECTS is a system for commensurability and comparison of the educational mechanism in different universities and countries, participating in the international academic exchange.

“Credit” in the ECTS context represents a workload unit the student expended in connection with his/her education in certain specialty, required for the successful completion of a semester or an academic year. Most frequently credits represent the time spared by the student for preparation on given discipline, both at attending lectures, as well as self-study assignment.

“The Grade” represents an index of student’s achievement when sitting for examination or implementing a concrete task, where different assessment systems are applied in the different states within the frames of the European Union. But all of them are equated to ECTS and securing in this way an equal standing among the students in different countries.

Eligibility of educational subjects and Interdisciplinary (study of other faculty disciplines) are among the basic principles of the system. Students have the opportunity to construct their own syllabus.

The Principle which applies within the ECTS framework is that there is a minimum requirement for accumulating of 60 credits per academic year or 30 for each semester.
