 font Times New Roman; dimensions: paragraph 10 mm; fields: upper, lower and left fields 2.5 cm; right 2.0 cm. When typing formulas, the Microsoft Equation Formula Editor, embedded in Microsoft Word, is used. Graphic objects should be grouped.
- 2. To the right of the middle of the sheet, the surname and the name of the author (s) (10 fonts, 1 interval, bold, italics), scientific degree, title, position, organization, e-mail (10 fonts, 1 st interval). Below, after 1 interval, the center of the page prints the title of abstracts (capital letters, bold, 12 fonts, 1-st interval). Below, after 1 interval (10 fonts, 1 st interval, italics), an annotation (up to 300 characters) and keywords (3-5 words) are submitted. Below, after 1 interval the summary of the main material (up to 10 thousand characters) (12 fonts, 1 interval) is presented. After the text, after 1 interval, the list of sources used in the order of references in the text of abstracts (10 fonts, 1 interval, italics) is indicated. For paper in Russian after the list of sources used 1 interval is duplicated in English with the surname and the name of the author (s) (10 fonts, 1 interval, bold, italics), scientific degree, academic rank, position, organization, e-mail (10 fonts, 1st interval). Title of the article (capital letters, bold, 12 fonts, 1 st interval), abstract and keywords (10 fonts, 1 st interval, italics).
- 3. Recommended abstracts of the report 3-5 pages.
- 4. Structure of material presentation: introduction, purpose, results of research, conclusions.
- 5. Abstracts are edited by the authors. The author is responsible for the content of the materials.
